WHAT IS IT?

The ability to think about facts, data, and information, understand it, analyze it, and form your own beliefs or create actions based off of it.



WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

Employers in all industries place high importance on hiring candidates with this skill. Having Critical Thinking skills can make it easier to find solutions to problems, which could greatly benefit any organization.



HOW CAN I GET BETTER AT IT?

- Participate in class or group discussions
- Genuinely and actively think about other peoples' ideas and perspectives
- Think objectively; set your own biases aside
- Ask questions



WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF IT?
